Data is stored as long as the customer relationship is valid and for six years after its termination. Only personnel authorized for the purpose have access to the data. Electronic data is protected with password protection and other technical safeguards such as firewalls. Data storage is done in locked and access-controlled premises.

### 10. Right to Inspect Personal Data and Right to Appeal to the Supervisory Authority

Those in the register have the right to inspect their own information, request correction of incorrect information, and file a complaint with the Data Protection officer.
